## Embedding YouTube Videos

### Introduction

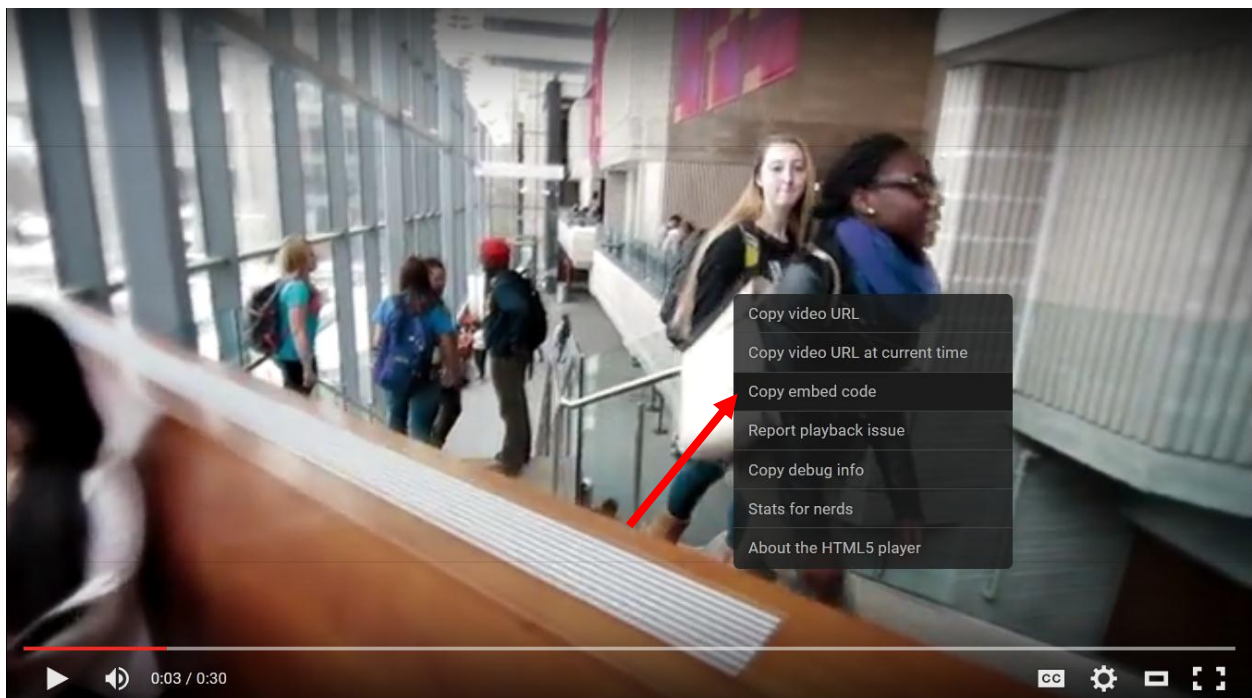
Follow the steps below to embed a YouTube video in your course site.

#### Step 1:

On YouTube.com, find the video you would like to embed in your course site.

#### Step 2:

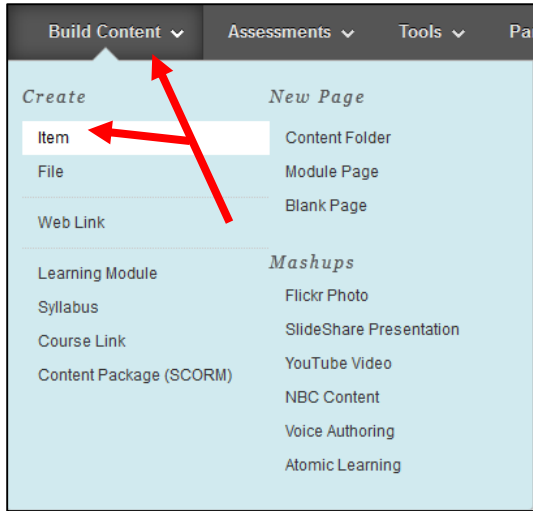
Right click on the video and choose "Copy embed code."

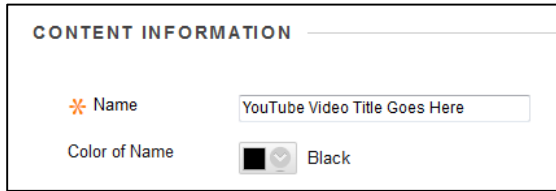
**Step 2:**

In the content area of a myCourses site that you would like to embed the video in, Click on “Build Content > Item.”



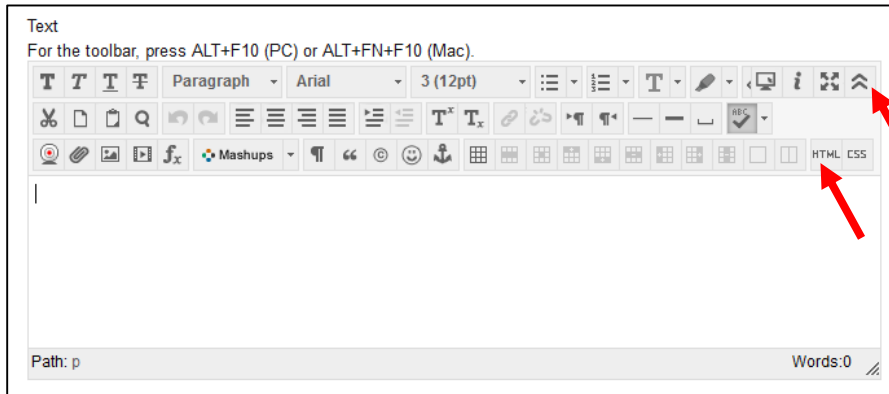
**Step 3:**

Enter the name you would like to appear above the video in the “Name” text box.



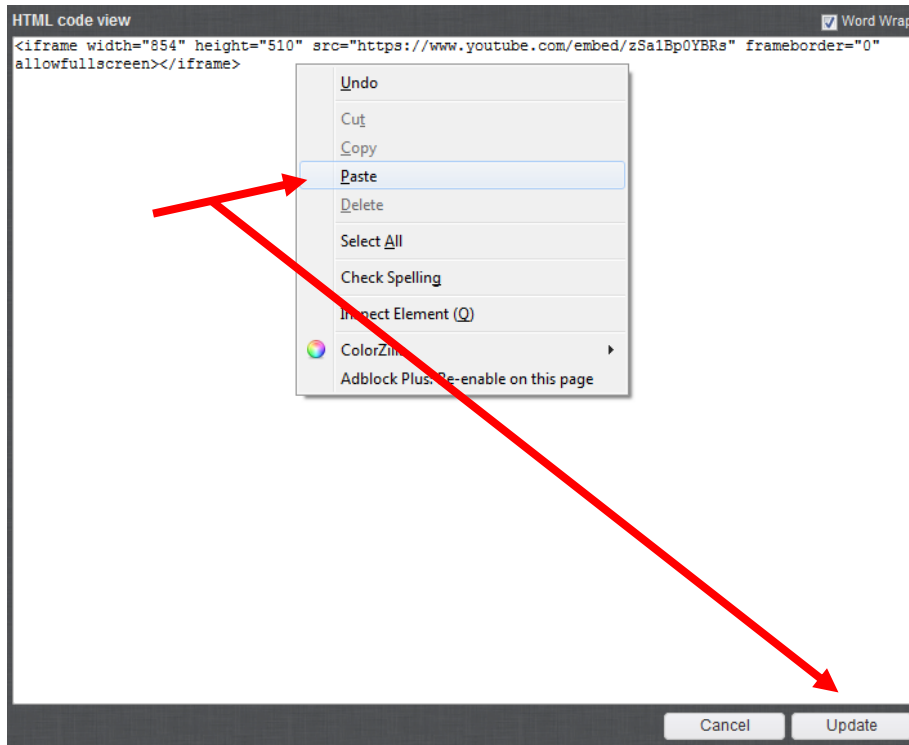
**Step 4:**

In the “Text” editor box, click the double arrow button on the far right end of the first row of buttons. Then, press the HTML button on the bottom row of buttons that appears.



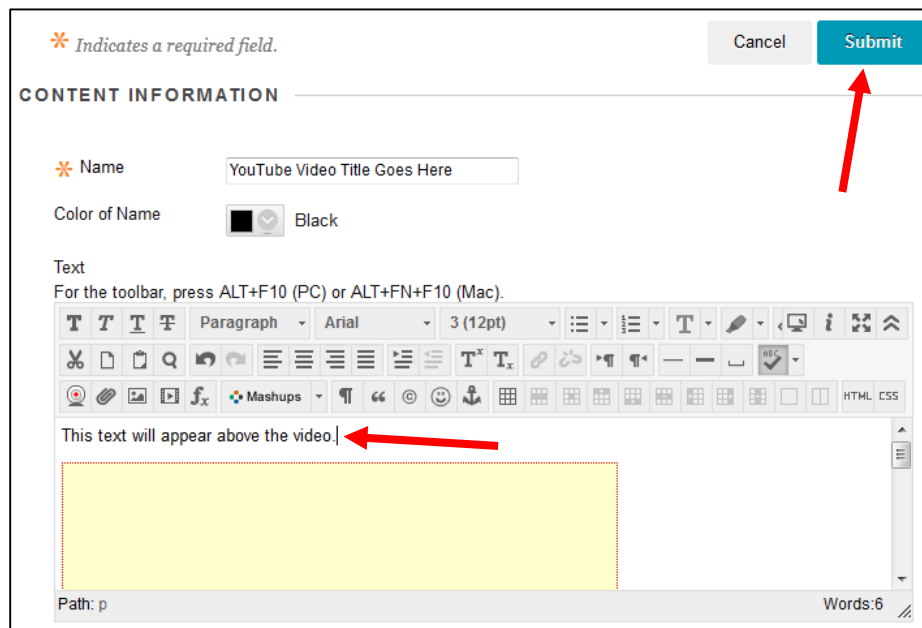
**Step 5:**

In the “HTML Code View” window that appears, right click on the white space and choose “Paste.” Then, press “Update.”



**Step 6:**

Add any text you would like to have appear above the video in the text box area, then press “Submit” to finish embedding your video.
