

Editing Auto Generated YouTube Closed Captions

When uploading a video, YouTube automatically generated closed caption text. However, the auto-generated captions are not fully accurate. In order to update the text of closed captions, please follow the steps below.

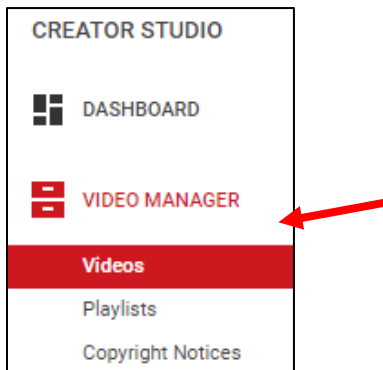
Step 1:

When logged into your YouTube account, click on the icon in the upper right corner and select Creator Studio.



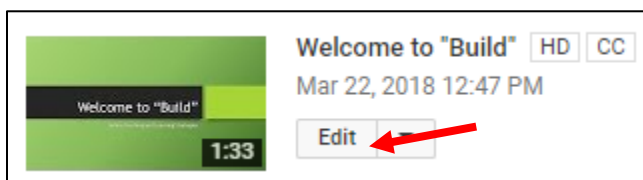
Step 2:

Choose Video Manager from the menu on the left side of your screen.



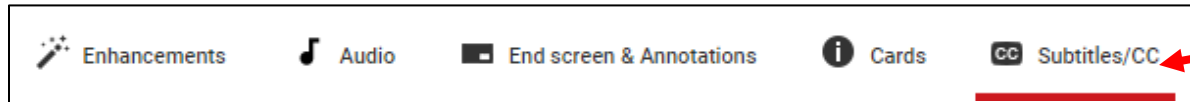
Step 3:

Click Edit under the title of the video you for which you would like to adjust captions.



Step 4:

Look to the top of your edit screen to locate the Subtitles/CC button along the top of your edit screen.



Step 5:

Navigate to the Published section and click English (Automatic).



Step 6:

To edit those captions to improve accuracy, locate and click Edit in the upper right corner of your screen.

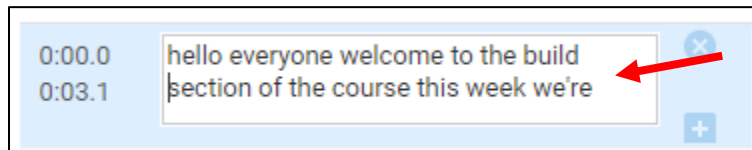


Step 7:

Press Play to begin listening to your video's audio and follow along with the captions YouTube automatically generated.

Step 8:

When discover an inaccuracy, insert your cursor into the text field(s) on the left for which you would like to adjust the caption and type changes.



Step 9:

Once you have listened to the video's audio in entirety and adjusted the caption text throughout, click Publish Edits in the upper right corner to update your video and secure changes.
