

Creating a Learning Module


Learning Modules allow you to create a book-like collection of materials focused on a specific subject that students can navigate through at their own pace. Instructors can create a structured path for progressing through the items. The path can be set so that students must view content sequentially, or set to permit users to view the content in any order. Learning Modules would not typically contain assignments or other activities - just static materials for students to review.

Example: Students use the Table of Contents to navigate through a Learning Module.

Step 1:

Click, **Build Content** along the top of a content area and choose **Learning Module**.



Step 2:

Enter a name for your Learning Module in the "**Name**" field and describe the materials you are going to be posting in the "**Text**" area.
